Education Grants - 2021

The Trustees have identified the following objectives as the basis for the award of grants. Trustees review these objectives periodically within the parameters set out in the CoTD's scheme.

Funding Priorities

1. Young persons mean those aged under 25 at the date of award
2. Applicants in the St Clements area, thereafter within the City of Oxford (OX1 to OX4 post codes)
3. Educational projects that supplement statutory services provided by local or national authorities, provided always that such statutory services are being provided by said authorities
4. Applications that benefit the maximum number of young people
5. Not for profit social projects and organisations that support the development of young people

Restrictions

6. Awards related to courses above foundation degree level or in the case of individual applicants for those who have previously received an individual grant award
7. Independent fee paying schools and universities.
8. Retrospective funding, i.e. work that has been completed by the time of Trustees decision.
9. Whilst each application is judged on its merits, ordinarily awards made to individuals applying in their own name are capped at £500 and in aggregate awards to schools and other organisations shall not exceed £10,000 in any 2 year period.
10. We do not fund statutory services that are required to be provided by local or national authorities.
11. The trustees have set a cap on the total value of individual awards that can be made each quarter.
